- 11.1 **QUALIFICATIONS:** Shall be a registered member of NSP and an experienced, licensed practicing attorney. Must be available for immediate notification about legal matters.
- 11.2 **APPOINTMENT AND SUPERVISION:** Shall be appointed by the Region Director and shall report to the Assistant Region Director for Administration.
- 11.3 **GENERAL DUTIES:** Shall meet the applicable planning, reporting, budgeting and records requirements listed under Ohio Region Officer's and Advisors General Duties (section 8).
- 11.4 **PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY:** Shall advise the Region Director and the Region Board of Governors on all matters having a legal bearing on Ski Patrol activities in the Ohio Region. Provides legal information of general importance to ski patrolling for distribution to Patrols and Patrollers in the Region.
- 11.5 **LEGAL CONSULTATION:** Shall be available to other Officers or Advisors of the Ohio Region for consultation on Ski Patrol matters.
- 11.6 **NOTIFICATION OF LEGAL ACTIONS AFFECTING NSP AND MEMBERS:** Serves as the first official point of contact on all pending or current legal actions affecting any Region Ski Patrol or Patroller based on NSP training or service to the public. When informed of an actual or potential legal action, is responsible for requesting the pertinent information and for promptly relaying it to appropriate Local, Section, Region, Division and National Ski Patrol officials.
