

- 14.1 **REGION REGISTRATION FEE:** Every Ski Patroller registering as a primary member with a Ski Patrol affiliated with the Ohio Region shall pay the annual Region registration fee when registering with the primary Patrol. The only membership classification that does not pay an annual registration fee to the Region is the Alumni Member.²⁰ Region registration fees are paid by Region Patrollers in all other membership classifications; candidates, skill levels, type service, and category. A Patroller registered in more than one classification is required to pay only one annual Region dues assessment. The Region annual registration fee, set by the Board of Governors is \$8.²¹
- 14.2 **REGISTRATION FEE PAYMENT:** All re-registering Ohio Region Ski Patrollers must pay their National, Division, Region, Section (if any) and primary Patrol registration fees to their primary Patrol and, when applicable, incremental Patrol registration fees to any secondary Patrol to be eligible to perform hill, hut, or trail duties as apropos once the ski area opens. Registration fees are considered paid beyond the local Patrol level only after received by the Division Registration Advisor. In the event that registration fees payment to the primary Patrol is contested, the Patroller must be able to verify the date and the amount by canceled check or receipt.
- 14.3 **LATE FEE:**²² A \$10.00 late fee must accompany each Patroller registration received by the Division Registration Advisor after the Division established cutoff date .
- 14.4 **PROCESSING OF REGISTRATION MATERIALS:** Registration materials will be distributed by the Region Registration Coordinator. Patrol re-registration papers and fees will be sent to the Division Registration Coordinator and a copy will be sent to the Region Registration Coordinator.

²⁰ Ohio Region collects no Alumni dues. Region dues for Alumni members could be considered if the alumni member receives any Region benefits, i.e., receives the *DOWNHILL*.

²¹ Ohio Region Registration fee was set at \$8 by the Region Board of Governors in June 1992.
