

- 29.1 **APPROVAL FOR FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES:** All Region fund raising activities must have the approval of the Region Board of Governors. This approval would normally be obtained as part of the annual program plan review during the Fall meeting. Fund-raising campaign expenditures may be charged against the receipts of funds raised for that campaign.
- 29.2 **ACCOUNTING FOR EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS:** Expenditures of funds that have been raised to meet specified needs or purposes, must be accounted for to show that the funds were used in accordance with originally specified intent.
- 29.3 **COORDINATION:** Any fund-raising activity other than collection of annual course, clinic and refresher fees conducted for or as a part of a Region program, shall be conducted by or coordinated with the Region Fund-raising Advisor. This does not apply to area Patrol fund-raising activities, but Patrol Directors are encouraged to notify the Region Fund-Raising Advisor of Patrol fund raiser plans to help avoid schedule conflicts.
- 29.4 **FUND-RAISING INCENTIVES:** Region fund-raising activities may include incentives for support paid to area Patrols.
