- 34.1 **QUALIFICATIONS:** Shall be a member of the National Ski Patrol in the Ohio Region, be professionally trained and certified in insurance matters and willing and able to undertake the duties of Insurance Advisor.
- 34.2 **APPOINTMENT AND SUPERVISION:** Shall be appointed by and report to the Region Director through the Assistant Region Director for Administration.
- 34.3 **GENERAL DUTIES:** Shall meet the applicable planning, reporting, budgeting and records requirements listed under Ohio Region Officer's and Advisors General Duties (section 8).
- 34.4 **PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY:** Serves primarily as an Advisor to the Region on liability insurance. Keeps informed about current insurance conditions and practices relative to liability, changes in laws affecting insurance in Ohio and Indiana, and National Ski Patrol and Division policies relative to liability and other types of insurance for Ski Patrollers.
- 34.5 **CONSULTANT DUTIES:** Be available as an information resource to Patrol Directors in obtaining answers to their questions about insurance from the National office and general insurance sources.
- 34.6 **GENERAL INFORMATION:** Provides information about insurance policy to Region meetings and to Patrollers through *DOWNHILL* articles.
- 34.7 **SOURCES FOR INSURANCE COVERAGE:** If requested by the Board of Governors, searches for insurance coverage needed but not met by National or Division programs.
- 34.8 **POSITION DEACTIVATED:** This position was deactivated by the Ohio Region Board of Governors at the 1993 Region Spring Meeting; however, this section was retained in the operations policies to meet possible future requirements.
