

- 36.1 **QUALIFICATIONS:** Shall be a registered Nordic patroller, preferably a Senior Nordic with a primary Nordic registration, certified as an NSP Nordic Skiing Instructor and either is or is will to become a Nordic Instructor Trainer and is capable and willing to provide the leadership necessary for the continuous development of the Nordic program in the Ohio Region.
- 36.2 **APPOINTMENT AND SUPERVISION:** Shall be appointed by and report to the Region Director through the Assistant Region Director for Programs.
- 36.3 **GENERAL DUTIES:** Shall meet the applicable planning, reporting, budgeting and records requirements listed under Ohio Region Officer's and Advisors General Duties (section 8).
- 36.4 **PRIMARY PURPOSE:** Shall promote uniformity among Nordic Patrols in the Ohio Region.
- 36.5 **DIVISION COORDINATION:** Shall maintain liaison with the Central Division Nordic Advisor.
- 36.6 **ON-THE-TRAIL REFRESHERS:** Shall supervise the organization and conducting of annual Nordic Trail Refreshers in the Ohio Region
- 36.7 **NORDIC SKI AND TOBOGGAN PROFICIENCY**⁴¹: Shall organize and administer Nordic Ski and Toboggan Phase II Instructor Training and clinics and evaluations for Nordic Patrollers at Basic and Senior levels. Shall lead a continuing Nordic Training Quality Assurance program in the Region.
- 36.8 **SENIOR NORDIC SKIING AND TOBOGGAN CLINIC COURSE COMPLETION RECORDS:** Shall submit Nordic Senior Skiing and Toboggan Clinic Course Completion Records as required in 8.11
