

- 38.1 **QUALIFICATIONS FOR POSITION:** Shall be a registered NSP Auxiliary member, preferably a Senior Auxiliary, in good standing, and is or is willing to become a Patroller Enrichment Seminar Trainer and is willing and able to provide the administrative leadership for the continued development of the Auxiliary program in the Ohio Region.
- 38.2 **APPOINTMENT AND SUPERVISION:** Shall be appointed by the Region Director and report through the Assistant Region Director for Programs.
- 38.3 **GENERAL DUTIES:** Shall meet the applicable planning, reporting, budgeting and records requirements listed under Ohio Region Officer's and Advisors General Duties (section 8).
- 38.4 **AUXILIARY RECORDS:** Shall maintain a record of all Region Auxiliaries and their assigned duties, including Advisorships and special projects.
- 38.5 **AUXILIARY INFORMATION DISSEMINATION:** Shall collect information about the Auxiliary program current requirements, standards, programs, awards, and developments and promptly disseminate it to all Patrols and to Ohio Region Officers through the *DOWNHILL*, direct mailing, and personal contacts.
- 38.6 **PATROLLER ENRICHMENT SEMINARS:** Responsible for administering the NSP Patroller Enrichment Seminar Program in the Region. Assures that Patroller Enrichment Seminars are available for patrollers within the Region at least every other year. Recruits trainers for the program and facilitates Phase II training for Region Instructor Candidates. If not an Instructor Trainer, obtains Instructor Trainers from outside the Region. Submits or supervises submission of Patroller Enrichment Seminar Course Completion Records as required in 8.11
