

- 45.1 **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE:** The Green Memorial was established in 1966 to perpetuate the memory of two brothers, members of NSP at the time of their deaths: Eric William Green, age 21, and Christopher Francis Green, age 18. It is a proficiency competition to honor the brothers and to promote friendly rivalry among Patrols and Patrollers. In September 1999 the Ohio Region Board of Governors changed the name to the Ohio Region Green Memorial.
- 45.2 **GREEN MEMORIAL FUND:** A memorial fund established in memory of the brothers was transferred to the Central Division on May 14, 1975 for the Division Outstanding Student Patroller (former Junior) Award, named the Eric and Chris Green Memorial Award. But the competition remains a program put on by the Ohio Region, in which Patrollers from all regions of the Central Division are invited to compete.
- 45.3 **DATE AND EVENTS:** The date of the competition, the competitive events, and the scoring are to be established no later than the Ohio Region fall meeting, and shall not be changed thereafter for that season except for emergencies. The competition will be publicized in the *DOWNHILL*.
- 45.4 **ENJOYABLE COMPETITION:** The competitive events shall be designed to be enjoyable to the competing Patrollers and shall not be highly-stressed duplicates of or similar to the tests given for first aid, skiing, or toboggan handling, although the events may call for the use of those skills.
- 45.5 **NO TEAM ENTRY LIMIT:** A Patrol may enter more than one team per class in the Ohio Region Green Memorial Competition.
- 45.6 **INTER-PATROL TEAMS:** In the Student division of the Ohio Region Green Memorial Competition, two or more Patrols, neither of which has enough Student Patrollers or candidates on its roster to form a team, may combine to form a team.
- 45.7 **LOW BUDGET:** The Ohio Region Green Memorial Competition will be supported by the fees collected from entrants, by contributions and fund-raisers, and when duly approved, funds from the Region Treasury. The program shall be planned for low costs so that fees are not a deterrent to Patroller participation.
