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- 48.1 **QUALIFICATIONS:** Shall be a registered member of NSP and a physician, MD or DO, licensed to practice in Ohio.
- 48.2 **APPOINTMENT AND SUPERVISION:** Shall be appointed by and report to the Region Director through the Assistant Region Director for Proficiency.
- 48.3 **GENERAL DUTIES:** Shall meet the applicable planning, reporting, budgeting and records requirements listed under Ohio Region Officer's and Advisors General Duties (section 8).
- 48.4 **DIVISION DUTIES:** Shall be a member of the Central Division Medical Committee.
- 48.5 **SUPPLEMENTAL TRAINING:** Shall prepare and present training programs requiring a medical background in areas relating to OEC and CPR that are either not covered or not covered in great depth by the OEC and ARC or AHA BLS-CPR courses of instruction: examples are the administration of oxygen, the use of sphygmomanometers, advanced trauma physiological information, and bloodborne pathogens .
- 48.6 **SECTION AND PATROL MEDICAL ADVISORS:** Shall encourage each Patrol Director and Section Chief to obtain and appoint a Medical Advisor.
