

- 56.1 **QUALIFICATIONS:** Shall be a registered Snowboard patroller, preferably a Snowboard Senior, Certified as an NSP Snowboard Instructor and either is or is willing to become a NSP Snowboard Instructor Trainer, and is willing to provide the leadership necessary for the continuous development of the snowboard program in the Ohio Region.
- 56.2 **APPOINTMENT AND SUPERVISION:** Shall be appointed by and report to the Region Director through the Assistant Region Director for Proficiency.
- 56.3 **GENERAL DUTIES:** Shall meet the applicable planning, reporting, budgeting and records requirements listed under Ohio Region Officer's and Advisors General Duties (section 8).
- 56.4 **PRIMARY PURPOSE:** Shall promote the NSP Snowboard Program among Sections and Patrols in the Ohio Region.
- 56.5 **DIVISION COORDINATION:** Shall maintain liaison with the Central Division Snowboard Advisor.
- 56.6 **REFRESHERS:** Shall supervise the organization and conducting of a Snowboard Patrolling Refreshers in the Ohio Region
- 56.7 **PROFICIENCY:** Shall work with the Alpine Senior Ski and Toboggan Clinic Advisor to organize and administer Snowboard Toboggan Phase II Instructor Training Courses and joint Ski/Snowboard Senior Clinics. Shall support, upon request, section and patrol level training programs for meeting basic patroller level snowboard and snowboard toboggan proficiency objectives. Shall lead a continuing Snowboard Training Quality Assurance Program in the Region. Submits or supervises the submission of Snowboard Clinic and Phase II Snowboard Toboggan Course Completion Records as required in 8.11 for the benefits of Senior Candidates.
