- \* The Fall Festivals @ the Highlands was a great success! Concern was raised over IT certification/ recert, this is being looked into a Division.
- \* Developed updated Toboggan Documents & Evaluation Forms for Senior TE & IT.
- \* Developing an Movement Analysis Course for IT's and Senior TE's offered this summer.
- \* Developing a mentoring program for OET Instructor Trainers in training.
- \* Developing a Toboggan Tips Document that will go out to all instructors in the Division.
- \* Developing a <u>Masters Course</u> to assist teaching and refreshing older patrollers. We will have Dale Mihuta: IT attend the training next December he will pass it along to the IT's
- \* The Spring Festivals at Crystal & Granite Peek were a great success! Look for them in 2025 again!
- \* Found a few of Ohio's Senior Ski/Ride TE's were not current with their PSIA credits or were not current OET instructors. Requirements include PSIA L2 and OET instructor both in good standing. We are working to finish the training in 2024 of our final person.

  - \* Offered Zoom MA clinic....looking to expand next year.
  - \* Offered STW @ BM (cancelled: no snow) Hope to offer one North & South next year.
  - \* Continuing to expand the links and info on the Region Webpage.

# ACTION POINTS: OET

## **RECRUITMENT:**

- Continue to recruit Instructors, <u>especially IT's</u>. Two resorts are working with only 1 Toboggan IT. Division is working on IT Mentoring Course & MA courses. You can attend on Zoom during the summer.
- **Region OET Instructors**: Updated form for mentoring instructors so their "local signoff" maybe be done by their home IT or can also be done by an IT from another area who is not related to the mentee. With two areas having only 1 IT, this will give people greater flexibility. Mentoring instructors could also have their skills signed off in a TES.
- \* **SKILLS DEVELOPMENT:** Continue to develop our skills as instructors. Renewing instructors will need to demonstrate their skills to remain instruments. Practice your skills every time you go out.

#### \* PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

- *Instructor MA Zoom:* Continue develop the Zoom MA Couse in conjunction with the Ski School and tie it into the STW. Next year we will try to schedule one in the north and another in the south.
- Yearly IT & T/E Skills Refresher @ Local Area with your staff: We don't practice enough.
- \* **Fall/Winter Festivals:** Alpine Skills Development Workshop
  - \* **Division:** Continue to nominate new people. Division is working to increase participants & number of offerings (PSIA clinics/Tests, Inst. Sign Off Opportunities, MA workshops, IT Prep Clinics) Look for More PSIA L1 tests, continuing education and new opportunities. We had a Great turnout this year!
  - \* **Region:** We will be offering STW's and TTW's.
  - **TTW/TES:** Some of our TES/TTW were extremely large this year. A few suggestions are:
    - 1. Offering the TES on both a Saturday and Sunday would help hs have fewer toboggan on the hill.
    - 2. Having a cut off for registration. Most registrations this year were from Wednesday on.
      - 3. Weekday Events

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- \* **SENIOR TEST:** We need to continue to reinforce practice skills so Demos are on point..
- MINI CLNICS: 2-3 hours 6-9pm or during the day. Scheduled as OET Skills Courses.
  We we try to use home or nearby IT's to teach. All courses would be run through the Region.
  Working on course descriptions and overview now.
  - \* **FUNdamentals for Toboggan Training:** Reinforcing the Toboggan Fundamentals.
  - \* Taming the Tail Rope: the entire clinic will be working on better tail rope technique
  - \* Mogul Masters: working to improve your mogul techniques
  - \* Toboggan Masters: For older Patrollers. (in works @ Central Division)
  - \* The Toboggan Experience: Challenge for Patrollers working for their Red Coats.
