### **MENTORING INSTRUCTOR SIGNOFFS: Reminders**

We have several people who are close to completing their Instructor Mentoring Path. The mentor should be able to demonstrate toboggan skills and maneuvers at a level of or above that of Alpine basics (if teaching that level for seniors, the level is senior level) and provide a well-crafted lesson based on the 6 Pack. A local IT will observe the mentoring instructor for teaching and demos and recommend them for final evaluation at a TTW or present a defined plan to address their deficiencies. To become certified, a mentoring instructor must attend a Toboggan Trainers Workshop (TTW) for final evaluation by an outside OET IT. It is the mentor's responsibility to return the completed Application and Mentoring Form (the one found on the Ohio Region OET Webpage) to me for my signature. Please assist them by ensuring that all the boxes are legible, completed, and signed before sending them to me. I will immediately send them to the Division for processing.
