OET Events:

Events were held on Zoom, at Boston Mills, Mad River Mountain, Perfect North Slopes, Paoli Peaks, and Snow Trails. We had a great season with great snow! Our participation numbers were very similar to last year. Thank you PDs for informing your patrollers about the events and providing lunch for participants. Members did a much better job this year registering for events early; in many cases, registrations were closed early before the event as we were at capacity. We are limited by how many toboggans we can put on the hill for the conditions. We also try to keep the group size to 5 or under so everyone has more time on the sleds. - * Six OET instructors did not to recertify this year. Two were injured but will recertify next year
- * Set up OET Records on the Region Google Drive to maintain
- * Thank you to **Dale Mihuta** who is leaving our IT cadre after many years. Over the years he has worked to develop and foster many techniques we currently use in OET at Region and Division level. He was also instrumental in developing the NSP-C Ski School. Please thank Dale for all his efforts on behalf of the OET Program.
- * Thank you also to **Greg Schoeneman** who became an Alumni Member this year. Hopefully we will consider joining us again! Greg has also been a longtime OET Instructor and IT for the Region!
- * OET New Instructor Zoom Session continues to help candidate be successful by providing them with an overview of the program and necessary paperwork. Please help us identify patrollers who should become OET Instructors. The Zoom clinic is the start of the training! The OET Instructor Path includes teaching, evaluating, and demo skills. It takes time to develop all of them. Your local IT is a great resource and an important part in your journey.
- * Continuing to expand the links and info on the Region Webpage linking it to Division page for the most up to date info.
- * We are looking to add a few STWs (Snowsports Trainer's Workshops) in the Region next year as we work to improve the teaching skills of our instructors.

ACTION POINTS: OET

* **RECRUITMENT:** Continue to get younger patrollers involved with our OET program.

* PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT as Instructors:

- Yearly IT & T/E Skills Refresher @ Local Area with your staff: We don't practice enough as instructors.
- Host a Region MA Zoom Course tied to an STW for instructors in the early season.
- * Fall/Winter Festivals: Dec 13-14 (not confirmed) @ the Highlands at Harbor Spring * Division: Continue to nominate new people to attend.
 - Investigate bringing back the Region Training event (Held in early Jan. We got away from it because of conditions and lack of snow)
- * TTW/TES: We still have larger events at PNS, so we might investigate holding on Saturday against the SES.
- * **SENIOR TEST:** TES: Continue working to Convert our TE to the OET TE certification.

- * **MVP Program & Frosty Refreshers**: The MVP program was never designed to replace the Frosty Refresher at your home area. The organization/structure of the Frosty is a local decision. If an alpine patroller is not successful in the Frosty, we suggest having a written policy with the steps needed to become proficient. Again, please include your ITs in these training decisions.
- * **MVP Program**: Needs better control for a Region Supervisor and guidance from Division. These are being addressed currently.
- * **National Waiver**: It would be wonderful if we could have a waiver on the National page so registering in two places is no longer required.

Thanks to everyone for a great season! Thanks to the Patrols and PDs who helped get the word out about events! A special thanks for providing lunch to the participants and staff. This helps us by reducing the time we spend inside. Also a huge thank you to ROSE!!!!
