## Instructor Development Administrator Report - Fall Meeting - September 2023

We have a decent cadre of ID Instructors across the Ohio Region but could use a couple more at 1-2 areas if we have interested patrollers. An ID Instructor course can be scheduled if there is sufficient interest.

All the needed documentation and forms for ID has been shared with all ID Instructors and I believe we have a couple of ID courses either in progress or starting soon.

One new development that National has created is another option to complete ID if someone wants to work independently or if an area does not have enough people to do a full class, etc. This option allows patrollers to complete the ID eCourse then National ID is offering regularly scheduled 3 hour Zoom sessions for them to complete the face to face teaching and Administration portion. I can provide more info on this option for those interested but it is laid out clearly in the NSP Center for Learning under ID.

This new option provides 3 ways for people to complete ID: 1) A full instructor-led course, 2) The hybrid course using the eCourse then face to face portion using the patrol local ID instructors, 3) the newly created option explained above.

Hopefully these actions and options set us up for success in the Ohio Region to enable us to provide quality ID courses that are consistent across the Region. As always, I am open to feedback and suggestions as to how to make this foundational course the best it can be for our up and coming instructors across all disciplines.
